Overhead scoreboard with sound effects ordered from air hockey table with sensors \$15

Mounts for the scoreboard (2) \$12 each

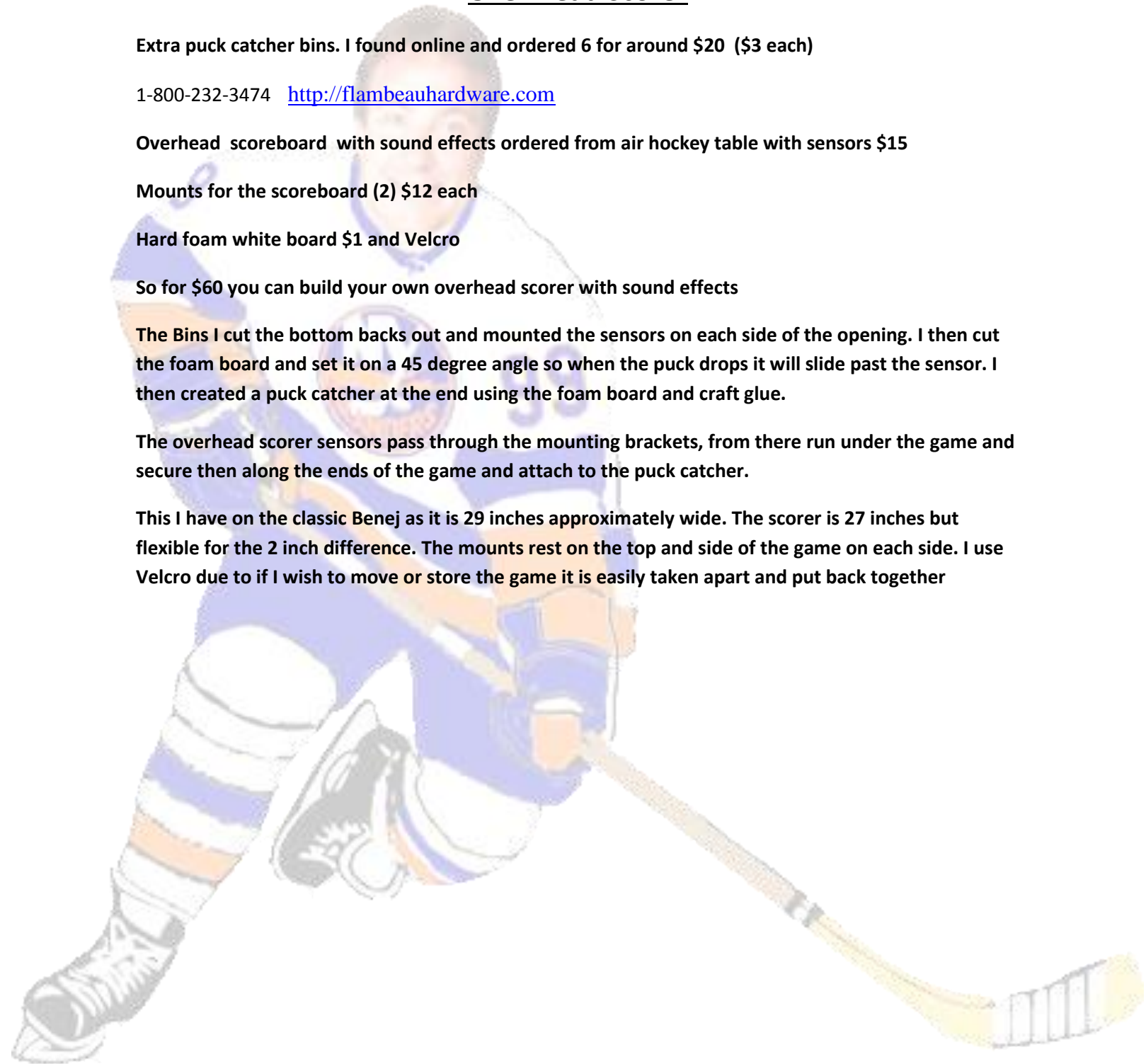
Hard foam white board \$1 and Velcro

So for \$60 you can build your own overhead scorer with sound effects

The Bins I cut the bottom backs out and mounted the sensors on each side of the opening. I then cut the foam board and set it on a 45 degree angle so when the puck drops it will slide past the sensor. I then created a puck catcher at the end using the foam board and craft glue.

The overhead scorer sensors pass through the mounting brackets, from there run under the game and secure then along the ends of the game and attach to the puck catcher.

This I have on the classic Benej as it is 29 inches approximately wide. The scorer is 27 inches but flexible for the 2 inch difference. The mounts rest on the top and side of the game on each side. I use Velcro due to if I wish to move or store the game it is easily taken apart and put back together
