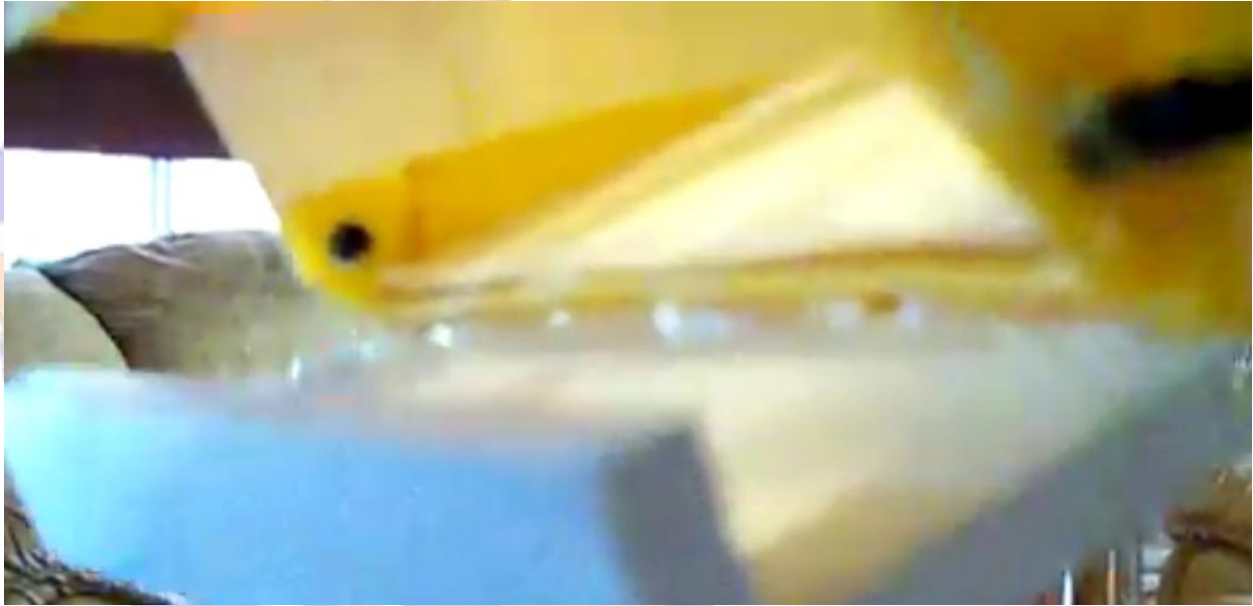

Hard Foam white board \$1 at any craft store, and Velcro craft store (AC Moore, Michaels, ETC)

So for around \$30 you can build your own side scorer

The Bins I cut the bottom backs out and mounted the sensors on each side of the opening. I then cut the foam board and set it on a 45 degree angle so when the puck drops it will slide past the sensor. I then created a puck catcher at the end using the foam board and craft glue.



The side scorer sensors pass through under the game then secure them along the ends of the puck catcher to sense the puck passing through. After testing, attach to the puck catcher foam and sensors (Use Craft Glue). The side Scorer-board mounts with Velcro on side board at center ice
